

Delmarva Cup Rules 11 vs. 11

1. Unless otherwise stated below, games will be played according to FIFA rules.
2. Teams are allowed unlimited substitutions. Substitutes may enter the game on all out of bounds plays or other game stoppages.
3. Games will consist of two (2) twenty five minute halves.
4. If overtime is required, there will be a penalty shootout with each team taking five penalty kick shots.
5. For Semi-finals and Finals matches, overtime play will include two 5 minute golden goal overtime periods followed by penalty kicks. Standard five shots per team format will be used for penalty kicks.
6. Teams will be seeded on a point system. Three (3) points will be awarded for a win, one (1) point for a tie and zero (0) points for a loss. The following tiebreakers will be used to determine seeding at the conclusion of pool play:
 - a. Head-to-head tiebreaker
 - b. Goal differential
 - c. Goals scored
 - d. Goals allowed
 - e. If teams remain tied, there will be a penalty shootout to break the tie.

Delmarva Cup Rules 8 vs. 8

1. No off sides will be called.
2. No slide tackling is permitted.
3. Unless otherwise stated below, games will be played according to FIFA rules.
4. Teams are allowed unlimited substitutions. Substitutes may enter the game on all out of bounds plays or other game stoppages.
5. Games will consist of two (2) twenty five minute halves.
6. No pass back to goalies hands.
7. If overtime is required, there will be a penalty shootout with each team taking five penalty kick shots.
8. For Semi-finals and Finals matches, overtime play will include two 5 minute golden goal overtime periods followed by penalty kicks. Standard five shots per team format will be used for penalty kicks.
9. Teams will be seeded on a point system. Three (3) points will be awarded for a win, one (1) point for a tie and zero (0) points for a loss. The following tiebreakers will be used to determine seeding at the conclusion of pool play:
 - a. Head-to-head tiebreaker
 - b. Goal differential
 - c. Goals scored
 - d. Goals allowed
 - e. If teams remain tied, there will be a penalty shootout to break the tie.
